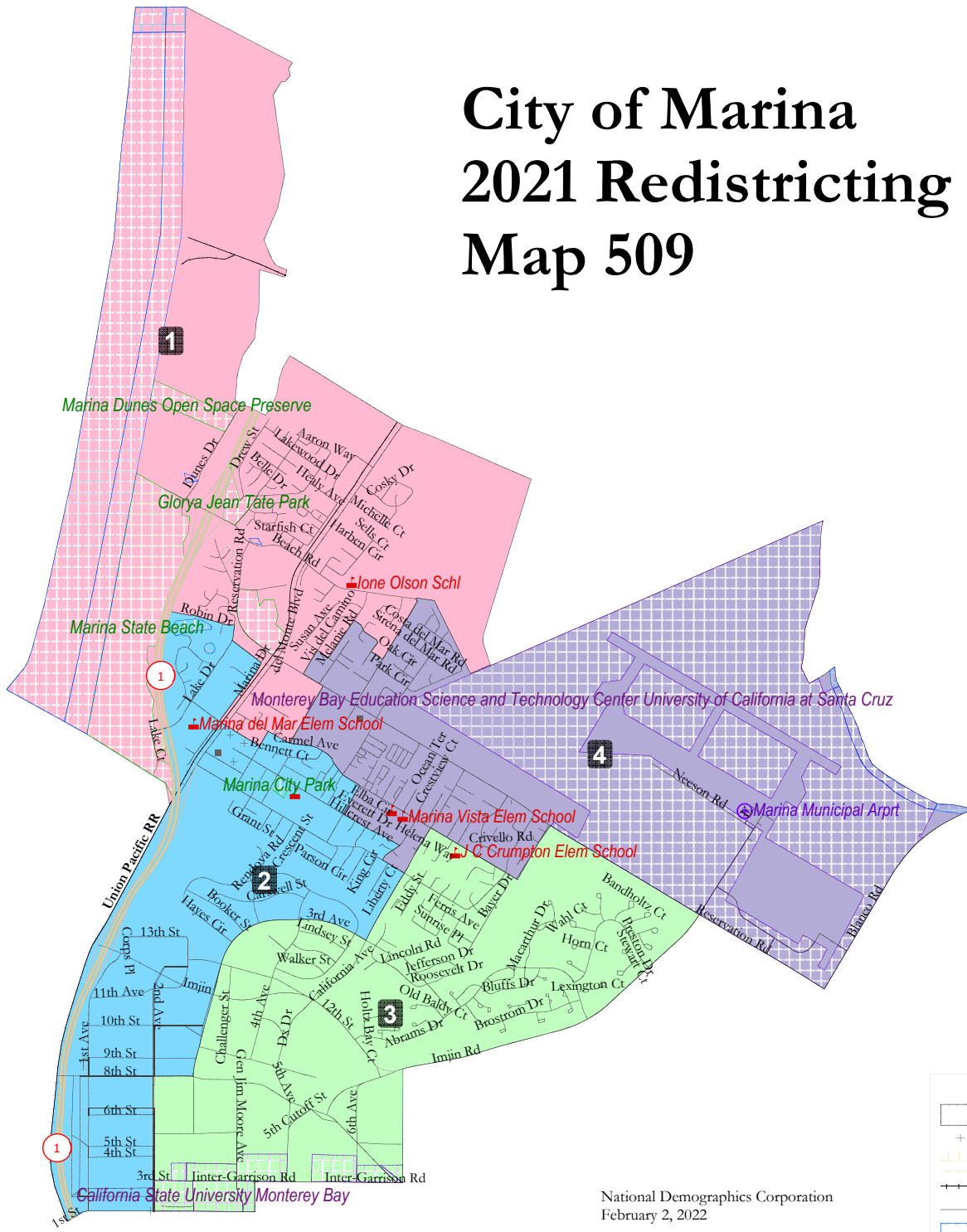


# City of Marina 2021 Redistricting Map 509
